

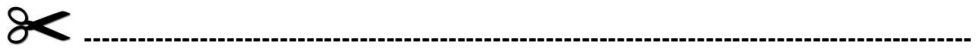
Travel Directions:

'O Come, O Come, Emmanuel'

An Advent Quiet Day

Led by John Grove and Revd Lynn Grove

The great 'O' Antiphons of Advent, expressed both in their original 9th century form and in the familiar Advent hymn 'O come, O come, Emmanuel', provide the theme for this Advent quiet day. Each antiphon emphasizes an attribute of the longed-for Messiah.

Their powerful images express the deep human longing for a different kind of world, the world described by Jesus as 'the Kingdom of God', a place of peace, justice and love.

We will explore the Scriptural source of each antiphon, as well as its meaning today, through spoken reflection, simple gesture, silence and song.

John Grove is a member of the Diocesan Training Team. He has long experience of lay ministry and training within the church and beyond. He is an Acorn Christian Listener and tutor. He is also a tutor on the York Diocesan 'Equipping God's people' programme. Before his early retirement he worked in banking and consultancy.

Revd Lynn Grove is non-stipendiary Associate Priest at St Peter & St Paul's Church, Pickering. Before ordination in 2004 she was a GP with a special interest in psychiatry and counselling. She is currently undertaking a course in Ignatian Spiritual Direction.
